



What to expect		
Our Curriculum		
At Thornhill Lees CE (VC) Infant and Nursery School, we deliver		
the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). We focus on the 3		
Prime Areas of Learning: Personal, Social and Emotional		
Development, Communication and Language and Physical Development.		

The characteristics of effective learning are also key:

- 1. Playing and exploring
- 2. Active Learning
- 3. Thinking creatively and critically

The children will learn through play. The 2YO Nursery staff carefully plan activities and opportunities linked to children's needs and interests.

Our Routine

When the children arrive at 2YO Nursery, they will self-register. They will then freely choose their learning in the 2YO Nursery classroom. They can access the outdoor area during the session. Please ensure your child has appropriate clothing for all weathers. During the session, they will join in with group times, which include singing, stories and music. The children will receive free fruit and milk every session.

Tapestry


We use Tapestry, which is an online learning journey to record your child's learning journey. Please make sure a member of the 2YO Nursery team has your email address. Once your child has started 2YO Nursery, you will be given details of how to login to Tapestry. When you are logged in, you will be able to see photographs and observations that have been made of your child. There will be 2 observations on Tapestry each half term.



Outdoor Play

All children will be given the opportunity to play outside whatever the weather. It is important that they wear weather appropriate clothing. Children will get wet, muddy and messy when they are playing outside.





Wow Wall

Please look at our 'wow wall' in 2YO Nursery to see some of the exciting things your child has been doing at Nursery!

Library

We have a selection of books that your child can borrow, to take home and share with you.

You will need a book bag to borrow books from 2YO Nursery. School book bags can be purchased from Nursery for £3.50. This book bag will be used throughout your child's time in school.

If a book gets damaged at home, parents will be charged £5 to replace it.

Nappies and Toilet Training

When your child is ready to start toilet training, the 2YO Nursery team will happily support you and your child in school. Please ensure your child has a bag with spare clothes and pants, in case they do have an accident.

If your child is still wearing nappies, it is your responsibility to provide 2YO Nursery with nappies, wipes, nappy bags and spare clothes.



Please make sure you take your child's spare clothes bag home every day.

Some things you can do at home with your child . . .

- Have conversations with your child. This is a really important thing to do, to support your child to learn to speak well.
- Read stories together every day. Look at the pictures and talk about the stories.



- Sing songs and nursery rhymes, including number rhymes.
- Get out and about and have fun!

children have been doing in Nursery. It does have a facility where you can send a message to the teacher. School Jotter is our whole school communication, please do not use Class Dojo to report absences.

Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND)

It is important that children with additional needs are identified as early as possible to ensure their needs are met. If a child has been identified as needing additional support, their teacher will meet with the school SENDCo (Mrs Gratino), who will help tailor make a package of support to help the child with their individual learning needs.
