Nursery Places

We currently have spaces in our 2 year old and 3 year old Nursery classes for September. If you have a child that will turn either 2 or 3 years old by 31st August, please pop into the office to find out more and pick up an application form.

For 2 year old Nursery, your child may be entitled to a funded place if you receive certain income-related benefits including Universal Credit, and also if both parents (or one parent in a single parent household) work more than 16 hours a week. Alternatively, parents are also able to pay for a place in 2 year old Nursery.

For 3 year old Nursery, all children are entitled to a 15 hour a week funded place.

If you would like to look around Nursery, please get in touch and we would be happy to show you around.

Car Park

Please can we politely remind parents that the car park is for staff use only. This includes before and after school times. Thank you for your understanding.

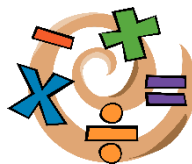
Curriculum Information Sessions
