
[Cake Sale](#)

[Nursery Places](#)

We currently have spaces in our 2 year old and 3 year old Nursery classes for September and January intakes. If you have a child that will turn either 2 or 3 years old by 31st August, or by 31st December, please pop into the office to find out more and pick up an application form.

For 2 year old Nursery, your child may be entitled to a funded place if you receive certain income-related benefits including Universal Credit, and also if both parents(or one parent in a single parent household) work more than 16 hours a week. Alternatively, parents are also able to pay for a place in 2 year old Nursery.

For 3 year old Nursery, all children are entitled to a 15 hour a week funded place.

If you would like to look around Nursery, please get in touch and we would be happy to show you around.
